<u>Building and Grounds</u> – Comm. Bellamy states, Monmouth County will be here on Money to remove the concrete. Marco will follow.

<u>Truck, Radios and Equipment-</u>Comm. DeGiglio states, Chief's truck is completed. The cost to add lights & sirens to the Deputy Chiefs car is \$481.83. Truck 489 will be donated to CERT Team in Aberdeen. Flow tests were completed on packs. The results were placed on an electronic card. The replacement parts are in for the racks. Ladder & Hose testing will take place the first week in September. Response system doesn't work properly, it needs an external antenna.
