## September 9, 2019

Open Public Meeting Act: The notice requirements provided for in the Open Public Meetings Act have been satisfied. Notice of this meeting was properly given in the Annual Notice of Meetings which was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners, March 7, 2007. Said resolution was transmitted to the Asbury Park Press, filed with the District Clerk and posted in the Cliffwood Fire House.

After the reading of the Open Public Meeting Act, the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, Township of Aberdeen was called to order on Monday, September 9, 2019 at 8:00PM in the Cliffwood Fire House.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of August 5, 2019 were passed out to all Commissioners and the public. Additions, corrections and/ or deletions will be addressed at the end of the meeting.

Comm. Marsh was absent, also Clerk, Yvette Bing

<u>Building and Grounds</u> – Comm. Bellamy states, the cost for widening the doorway between back bay and truck room, using Marco would be \$750.00. It was suggested that we may be able to fix the kitchen door that sticks, by grinding the paint first. The discussion of painting the truck room and hallway will be put off until October. Comm. Connelly makes a motion to get the doorway widened, Comm DeGiglio seconds it. Comm. Bellamy reads a request letter from Yvette Bing for the use of the Firehouse Nov. 2, 2019.

<u>Truck, Radios and Equipment-</u> Comm. DeGiglio states, Chief's truck is out in Millstone, getting more lights put on it at no cost. The hoses were all tested and passed. Ladder passed as well. Would like to start putting money away for a new ladder truck, perhaps by the 100th anniversary. Chief's car will soon need an oil change once it returns from Wildwood

<u>Old Business</u> – Comm. DiGiglio states that no one has responded to the chief on needing Hep B shots. There will be 16 Fire trucks to look at during the convention.

<u>New Business</u> – Comm. Connelly, proposes new rules on how Life members get paid for the Wildwood convention. Comm. Connelly makes a motion that new rules be put in place going forward. Comm. DeGiglio seconds it. Rules will be in written form and read off at next meeting. Comm. Black thanks the Board for their support during the loss of his Father.

Insurance – Comm. Black reiterates, all went well with the audit.

<u>Chief's Report</u> – Chief asks for 494 to go to Wildwood.

Bureau of Fire Prevention - Comm. Bellamy reads report. \$4,587.10 was deposited in the Boards account. \$1,342.90 for 4th Qtr Lea rebate and \$60 for 4 fire reports, was deposited in the BFP account. Fire Official would like to order lighter uniform shirts for the warmer days. Would also like permission to take 489 to Wildwood. Cliffwood Elementary classes will be in attendance for Fire prevention week. Supplies will be ordered. Platinum Car wash offers unlimited washes for \$100 per month. Would like to take Vacation when 489 gets serviced. Comm. Connelly would like to transfer funds in the amount of \$52,371.13 form 2B1 to Money market to cover some truck costs. Comm. Connelly makes a motion, Comm. Black seconds it.

<u>Training grounds</u> – Comm. Bellamy states, Insurance inspection passed. Burn tank is being replaced. There's \$18, 960.50 in the joint account. \$5,000 pays for the household bills. Looking to paint the wooden structure around the pit. No pricing yet.

<u>Public</u> – Steve Gallant talks about the door handle upstairs needing to be replaced. Comm. Connelly excepts previous months minutes. Comm. Black seconds it.
