#### February 6, 2023

Open Public Meeting Act: The notice requirements provided for in the Open Public Meetings Act have been satisfied. Notice of this meeting was properly given in the Annual Notice of Meetings which was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners, March 7, 2007. Said resolution was transmitted to the Asbury Park Press, filed with the District Clerk and posted in the Cliffwood Fire House.

After the reading of the Open Public Meeting Act, the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, Township of Aberdeen was called to order on Monday, February 6, 2023 at 7:00PM in the Cliffwood Fire House.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of January 9, 2023 were passed out to all Commissioners and the public. Additions, corrections and/ or deletions will be addressed at the end of the meeting.

<u>Building and Grounds</u> – Comm. Black states, waiting for a call on Tenant for repair of floor cleaner. Waiting on Zieglar for breakdown of costs of fans.

<u>Truck, Radios and Equipment-</u> Comm. DeGiglio reports, PM's are done. The gear needed a name change. Should be back in a week. Costs will be \$100 per coat. Would like to order Chief 360. \$199 for set up. Total cost is \$755 for the year. Radio's were ordered. Should take a month or two to come in. Would like to go to Harrisburg for 2 days in May. Comm. Gallant makes a motion to pay for two nights in a hotel. Comm. Logan seconds it. All were in favor. Once budget passes, would like to order Hose Rollers. Comm. DeGiglio recommends Rosenbauer. Comm. Black agreed.

<u>Old Business</u> – Comm. Logan states that Losap is in the works. Comm. Gallant states that the Chief didn't hand in a report for Nov and would like to see them monthly. Comm. Bellamy asks about classes that were taken with no certificates issued such as the RIT team guys.
