## January 9, 2023

Open Public Meeting Act: The notice requirements provided for in the Open Public Meetings Act have been satisfied. Notice of this meeting was properly given in the Annual Notice of Meetings which was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners, March 7, 2007. Said resolution was transmitted to the Asbury Park Press, filed with the District Clerk and posted in the Cliffwood Fire House.

After the reading of the Open Public Meeting Act, the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, Township of Aberdeen was called to order on Monday, January 9, 2023 at 7:00PM in the Cliffwood Fire House.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of December 5, 2022 were passed out to all Commissioners and the public. Additions, corrections and/ or deletions will be addressed at the end of the meeting.

<u>Building and Grounds</u> – Comm. Black states, brought snow blower in. We have 5 1/2 bags of salt and 2 snow shovels. We need better ones and a new broom and pan. Made an air gage to plug into every hose. Comm. Bellamy states the fuses are popping on cleaning machine. Will have to be serviced. Hot water heater was leaking. Fizer Plumbing repaired it and added an expansion tank.

<u>Truck, Radios and Equipment-</u>Comm. DeGiglio reports, Order was placed but vendor didn't see it, so air bottles weren't ordered. Hoses and Shields are ordered. Helmets are not needed right now. Turn out gear had a problem with knee pads. They were changed and ordered. Should be received within two weeks. Got the right chargers \$80.066 for 15 from Harris radios. No squealing. Requires permissions if no VHF. Will receive within three to four weeks if we choose Harris. Motorola costs a lot more. We need to have meetings about the New Truck. Comm. Bellamy asks how we came about an ISO meeting. Comm. suggests the officers sit down with the ISO people which can improve our ratings. Comm. Bellamy spoke of having old turn out gear.

Old Business – Comm. Logan asks about the qualifications for Losap.

New Business – Comm. Bellamy reminded folks that the Officers will be sworn in on Saturday. Also, there is a fire election on Sat. 2/18/23. Commissioners agreed to raise John Purcells salary from \$145-\$175 per month.
